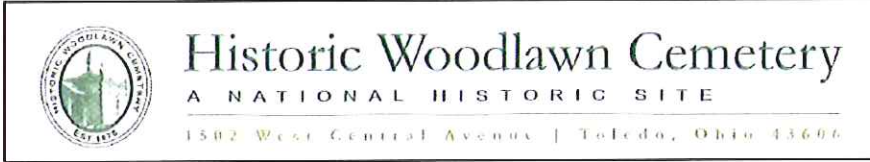

Historic Woodlawn Cemetery Project

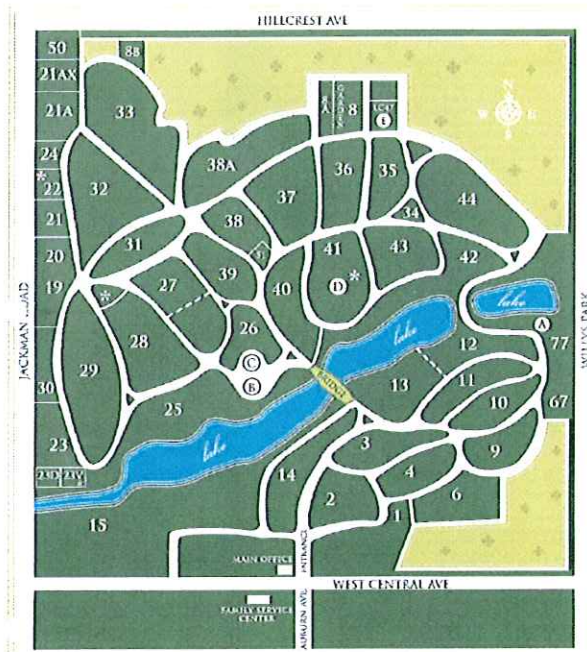


This unique project will give Scouting an avenue to give back to the community by helping restore a national historical site.

With the Historic Woodlawn Cemetery being an older cemetery (founded in 1876), many of the original grave markers throughout the cemetery have come out of the ground and out of position due to poor foundations and the settling of the ground over many years.



This worthwhile 100th Anniversary project will consist of resetting and straightening the markers along Jackman Road on the west boundary of the cemetery. The project will cover approximately 300' along Jackman, which is about 600 grave markers.
